KEY OVERSEAS MARKET

US markets closed lower on Thursday as investors assessed the latest batch of economic data and as Treasury yields steadied ahead of a key inflation report. Investors were also watching developments in Washington to see whether US lawmakers could avert a government shutdown. The Dow Jones Industrial Average closed up 0.35%, while the S&P 500 and Nasdaq Composite were up 0.59% and 0.83% respectively.

Other key markets ended mixed. European stocks closed as follows: the FTSE100 (+0.11%), the Dax 30 (+0.70%), CAC 40 (+0.63%) and the STOXX (+0.72%). In Asia, the Hang Seng and Shanghai indices closed lower. The key Asian indices ended yesterday as follows: Nikkei 225 (-1.54%), HSI (-1.36%) and the Shanghai Composite (+0.10%).

The yield on the US 10 - year note was at 4.579%, while the 2 - year note was at 5.062%. Oil was down to \$93.84 per barrel, up 3.84%. The gold price was at US\$1894.10 per ounce, down 1.34%.

NZX & ASX

The S&P/ASX200 closed higher on Thursday, -0.09% to 7,024.80 points. The bottom performing stocks in this index were BRICKWORKS LIMITED (-6.42%) WASHINGTON H SOUL PATTINSON & COMPANY LIMITED (-6.03%). The index has lost in last five days.

The S&P/NZX 50 closed lower at 11178.035 points down 1.25%. Most sectors ended lower. The 3 best sectors were Consumer Discretionary (-0.02%), Materials (-0.23%), Industrials (-0.50%). The 3 worst sectors were Health Care (-2.20%), Energy (-1.90%) and Consumer Staples (-1.79%).
