Top News KEY OVERSEAS MARKET

The US markets rebounded on Tuesday as a spate of quarterly earnings reports and hints at the de-escalation of US-China trade tensions brought buyers in from the sidelines.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average up 2.66%, while the S&P 500 and Nasdaq Composite were up 2.51% and 2.71% respectively.

Other key markets ended higher. European stocks closed as follows: the FTSE100 (+0.64%), the Dax 30 (+0.41%), CAC 40 (+0.56%) and the STOXX (+0.53%). In Asia, the Hang Seng and Shanghai indices closed higher. The key Asian indices ended yesterday as follows: Nikkei 225(-0.17%), HSI (+0.78%) and the Shanghai Composite (+0.25%).

The yield on the US 10 - year note was at 4.401%, while the 2 - year note was at 3.821%. Oil was up to \$63.54 per barrel, up 1.81%. The gold price was at US\$3392.00 per ounce, down 0.97%.

NZX & ASX

The S&P/ASX200 closed higher on Tuesday, down 0.03% to 7,816.70 points. The worst performing stocks in this index were PALADIN ENERGY LTD (-12.53%) and ZIP CO LIMITED. (-9.04%). The index has gained 0.71% in last five days.

The S&P/NZX 50 closed at 11836.69 points up 2.33%. Most sectors ended lower. The 3 worst sectors were Financials (-3.68%), Communications Services (-3.12%), Health Care (-2.42%). The 3 best sectors were SmallCap (+0.65%), Materials (+0.18%) and Consumer Discretionary (-0.19%).
